



## CURLY SCARF – Crochet Tutorial



A long reversible scarf made out of crochet motifs joined with each other in the process of work.

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: approximately 12" (30 cm)

Length: approximately 80" (2 m)

### RECOMMENDED MATERIALS

**Yarn:** **James C. Brett Marble Chunky** acrylic yarn (7.1 oz /200 g, 341 yds /312 m), 1 ball

**Substitute yarn:** **Chunky weight acrylic or blend yarn**, above yardage

**Crochet hook:** US K (6.5 mm) hook

### GAUGE

Approximately 5 tr / dc sts = 2" (5 cm)\*

One motif is approximately 12" x 9" (23 cm) x 5" (13 cm)

*\*Somewhat larger gauge is acceptable (scarf will come out a bit wider and shorter)*

### ABBREVIATIONS

**ch:** chain

**dc:** double crochet

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**sl:** slip st

**tr:** treble st

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note.** The scarf is reversible; every other motif appears on its wrong side (which looks similar to the right side).

### **1<sup>st</sup> motif**

Ch 6 and join with sl st into ring.

**Row 1:** ch 4 (counts as tr), 17 tr in ring (=18 tr composing semi-circle), ch4 (counts as 1<sup>st</sup> tr of next row), turn.

**Row 2:** tr in each of first 2 tr, \*ch 5, tr in each of next 3 tr, rep from \* to end of row (=5 spaces and 6 clusters of 3 tr), turn.

**Row 3:** sl in 3<sup>rd</sup> tr from hook, \*10 dc in space of ch 5, skip 2 tr, sl in next tr (last in group of 3 tr); rep from \* to end of row. Then work 2<sup>nd</sup> motif.

### **2<sup>nd</sup> motif**

Ch 6, join into ring, ch 4 (counts as tr of next row), turn.

**Row 1:** 17 tr in ring, ch 4 (counts as 1<sup>st</sup> tr of next row), turn.

**Row 2:** tr in each of first 2 tr, \*ch 5, tr in each of next 3 tr, rep from \* to end of row, sl to join with 1<sup>st</sup> motif ring (shown as '1' in photo below), turn.

**Row 3:** sl in 3<sup>rd</sup> tr from hook, \*10 dc in space of ch 5, skip 2 tr, sl in next tr (last in group of 3 tr); rep from \* to end of row. Then work 3<sup>rd</sup> motif.


### **3<sup>rd</sup> motif**

Ch 6, join into ring, ch 4, turn.

**Row 1:** 17 tr in ring, ch 4, turn.

**Row 2:** tr in each of first 2 tr, \*ch 5, tr in each of next 3 tr, rep from \* to end of row, sl to join with space between 2 last groups of 10 dc sts of previous motif in same line (shown as '2' in photo), turn.

**Row 3:** sl in 3<sup>rd</sup> tr, \*10 dc in space of ch 5, skip 2 tr, sl in next tr; rep from \* to end of row.



Work **next motifs** each as 3<sup>rd</sup> motif until yarn ball is finished (sample scarf has total 19 motifs). Join last motif in sl st with previous motif and fasten off.

## Finishing

Steam press the scarf on both sides with an iron.
