

COLLARED CARDIGAN

Vintage 1980s Knitting Patterns



** Please see last page for sizes and abbreviations **

These directions are for small size (8-10).
Changes for medium size (12-14) and large size
(16-18) are in parentheses.

MATERIALS

BERNAT WILLOWSPUN (50 gram balls)
– 8(9-10) Main Color (M C)
– 6(6-7) Contrasting Color (C C)
1 pair each BERNAT straight knitting needles
Nos. 10 and 11
(Canadian Needles Nos. 4 and 1) (6mm and
7½mm)

OR ANY SIZE NEEDLES THAT WILL GIVE
THE STITCH GAUGE GIVEN BELOW
4 buttons

GAUGE: 3 sts = 1 inch

PATTERN STITCH

Row 1: Using C C, K 1, * sl 1 as if to P, K 2,
repeat from * across row.

Row 2: Using C C, knit.

Row 3: Using M C, * K 2, sl 1 as if to P, repeat
from *, ending K 1.

Row 4: Using M C, knit.

Repeat these 4 rows for pattern stitch.

BACK: Using larger needles and M C, cast on 61(64-70) sts. Join C C and work even in pattern st until piece measures 17 inches, ending with a right side row. **SHAPE ARMHOLES:** At the beg of each of the next 2 rows bind off 4 sts. Dec 1 st each end of needle every other row 2(2-3) times. Work even in pattern as established on 49(52-56) sts until armholes measure 7½(8-8½) inches. Bind off.

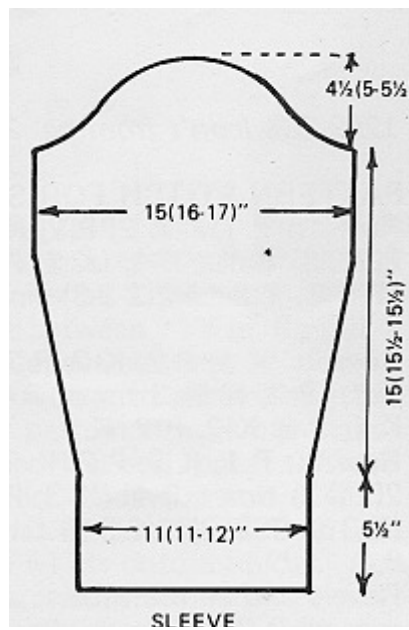
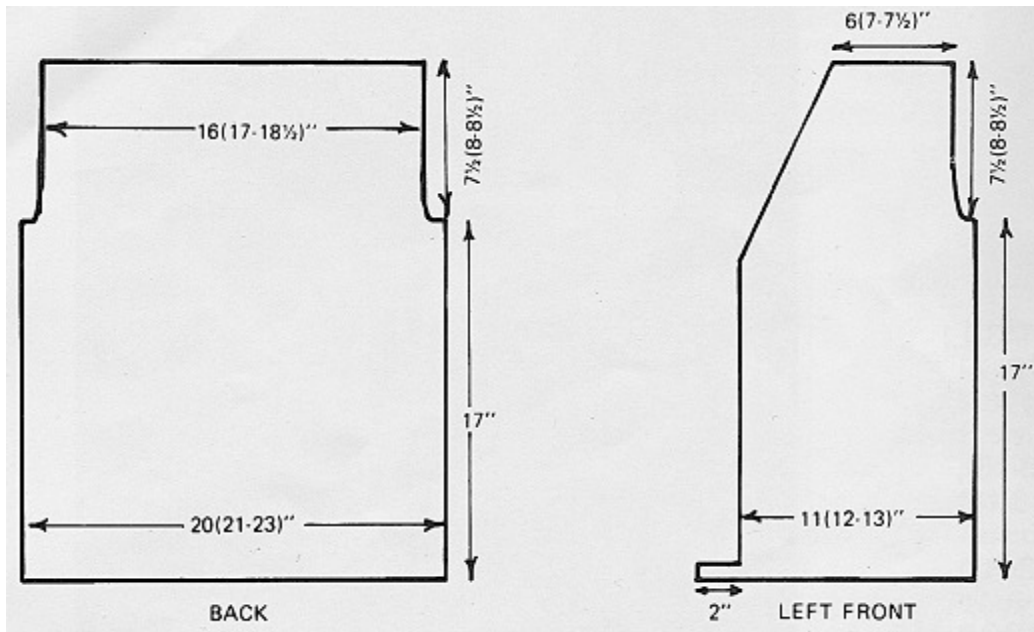
POCKET LINING: Make 2. Using smaller needles and M C, cast on 18 sts. Work even in stockinette st for 4½ inches, ending with a P row. Sl sts onto a holder.

LEFT FRONT: Using larger needles and M C, cast on 40(43-46) sts. Join C C and work in pattern st on 34(37-40) sts; sl remaining 6 M C sts onto a holder to be worked later for frontband. Continue in pattern st on 34(37-40) sts until piece measures 5¾ inches, ending with Row 3. **FORM POCKET OPENING:** Using M C, K 8(11-14) sts, bind off the next 18 sts, K to end of row. **INSERT POCKET:** Continuing in pattern st, work in pattern st to pocket opening, work 18 sts of one pocket lining onto same needle, work to end of row. Continue in pattern st until piece measures 15 inches. **SHAPE NECK:** On the next row at neck edge dec 1 st and repeat this dec every 1 inch 8(8-9) times more, and **AT THE SAME TIME**, when piece measures 17 inches, ending with the same row of pattern st as on back at underarm, **SHAPE ARMHOLE:** At arm edge bind off 4 sts. Dec 1 st at same edge every other row 2(2-3) times. When all neck decs have been completed, work even if necessary on 19(22-23) sts until armhole measures 7½(8-8½) inches, ending with same row as on back at shoulder edge. Bind off.

RIGHT FRONT: Work to correspond to left front, reversing placing of frontband, pocket and all shaping.

SLEEVES: Using larger needles and M C, cast on 34(34-37) sts. Work even in pattern st for 3½ inches, ending with Row 4. Using C C, K the next row to form hemline. Then using M C and starting with Row 3 of pattern st, continue in pattern as established until entire piece measures 5½ inches. On the next row inc 1 st each end of needle and repeat this inc every 2 inches 5(6-6) times more, forming new patterns as sts are inc. Work even in pattern as established on 46(48-51) sts until piece measures 20½(21-21) inches, ending with same row of pattern st as on back at underarm. **SHAPE CAP:** At the beg of each of the next 2 rows bind off 4 sts. Dec 1 st each end of needle every 3rd row for 4½(5-5½) inches. At the beg of each of the next 4 rows bind off 2 sts. Bind off remaining sts.

FINISHING: Sew shoulder seams. Set in sleeves. Sew underarm and sleeve seams, reversing 3½ inches of seam at lower edge of sleeve to form cuff. **LEFT FRONTBAND:** With right side facing you, sl 6 sts onto smaller needle, join M C at inner edge and work in garter st until piece is same length as front to start of neck shaping, stretching slightly. **SHAPE COLLAR:** On the next row at inner edge, inc 1 st and repeat this inc every other row 13 times more. Work even on 20 sts until piece fits around neck edge to centre back. Bind off. **RIGHT FRONTBAND:** Work to correspond to left frontband and collar, forming first buttonhole when piece measures 2 inches. **BUTTONHOLE:** Starting at front edge, K 2 sts, bind off the next 2 sts, K 1. On the next row, cast on 2 sts over those bound off previous row. Make 3 more buttonholes, evenly spaced - the last one to be made 1 inch below start of neck shaping. Seam collar and sew frontbands and collar in place. Sew pocket linings in place. Sew on buttons.
