

PULLOVER In Bead Ribbing

1980s Knitting Pattern



Sizes: Women's L, XL and XXL

Finished chest measurements: 43" (size L), 45 $\frac{1}{4}$ " (size XL) and 47 $\frac{3}{4}$ " (size XXL)

Directions are for size L, with changes for XL and XXL in parentheses when applicable

MATERIALS

Pingouin's "Minou": 22 (24/ 25) balls of color Corail No. 11.

Sizes 4 and 8 needles or any size to obtain gauge.

STITCHES USED

1/1 ribbing:

Row 1 and all odd-number rows: * K 1, P 1 *.

Row 2 and all even-number rows: work sts as they present themselves (i.e. K the K sts and P the P sts).

Beaded ribbing:

Row 1 and all odd-number rows (right side of work): K.

Row 2 and all even-number rows: * P 1, K 1 into center of st below next st (so that both are knitted at same time = 1 double stitch) *, P 1.

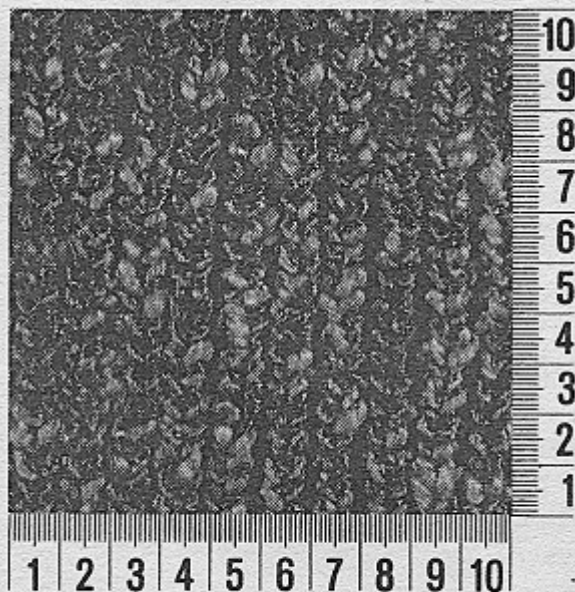
Double decrease 4 sts from edge:

At beginning of row: work 4 sts, K 3 tog, then cont work across row.

At end of row: when 7 sts remain on left-hand needle, sl 1, K 2 tog, PSSO, then work rem 4 sts.

**TO SAVE TIME,
TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE !**

Using size 8 needles in beaded ribbing: 4" x 4"
= 20 sts x 40 rows.



Note: Gauge in pic. above is metric (10 cm = 4")

INSTRUCTIONS

BACK

With smaller size needles, cast on 98 (102/ 106) sts and work 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in 1/1 ribbing, inc 11 (13/ 15) sts evenly spaced across last row. You now have 109 (115/ 121) sts.

With larger size needles work in beaded ribbing.

When work measures 12 $\frac{3}{8}$ " (13 $\frac{3}{8}$ "/ 14 $\frac{1}{8}$ ") from beg, **shape raglan armholes:** make a double dec 4 sts away from each outer edge: every 6th row 13 times, then every 4th row 7 (8/9) times. For **neckline:** bind off rem 29 (31/ 33) sts in one row.

FRONT

Beg work same as for back.

When work measures 12 $\frac{3}{8}$ " (13 $\frac{3}{8}$ "/ 14 $\frac{1}{8}$ ") from beg, **shape raglan armholes:** make a double dec 4 sts away from each outer edge: every 6th row 13 times, then every 4th row 4 (5/ 6) times.

When work measures 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (21 $\frac{3}{8}$ "/ 22 $\frac{1}{8}$ ") from beg, **shape neckline:** bind off center 11 (13/ 15) sts, then finish each side separately while binding off on each neckline edge, every 2nd row: 4 sts 1 time, 3 sts 3 times, and 2 sts 1 time. Bind off rem st on each side.

RIGHT SLEEVE

With smaller size needles, cast on 50 (52/ 54) sts and work 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in 1/1 ribbing, inc 13 (15/ 17) sts evenly spaced across last row. You now have 63 (67/ 71) sts.

With larger size needles work in beaded ribbing, inc 1 st at each outer edge: every 6th row 18 (16/ 14) times, then every 8th row 0 (2/ 4) times. Work new sts into pat as you inc. You now have 99 (103/ 107) sts.

When work measures 14 $\frac{3}{8}$ " (15 $\frac{3}{8}$ "/ 16 $\frac{1}{8}$ ") from beg, **shape raglan cap:** make double decs 4 sts away from edge, same as for front on right edge and same as for back on left edge. At same time, in same row as 3rd dec which is every 4th row, **shape top edge:** bind off center

6 sts, then finish each side separately, binding off on each neckline edge, every 2nd row: on **right:** 5 sts 2 times and on **left:** 2 sts 1 time and 1 st 7 times.

LEFT SLEEVE

Work same as for right sleeve, reversing shapings.

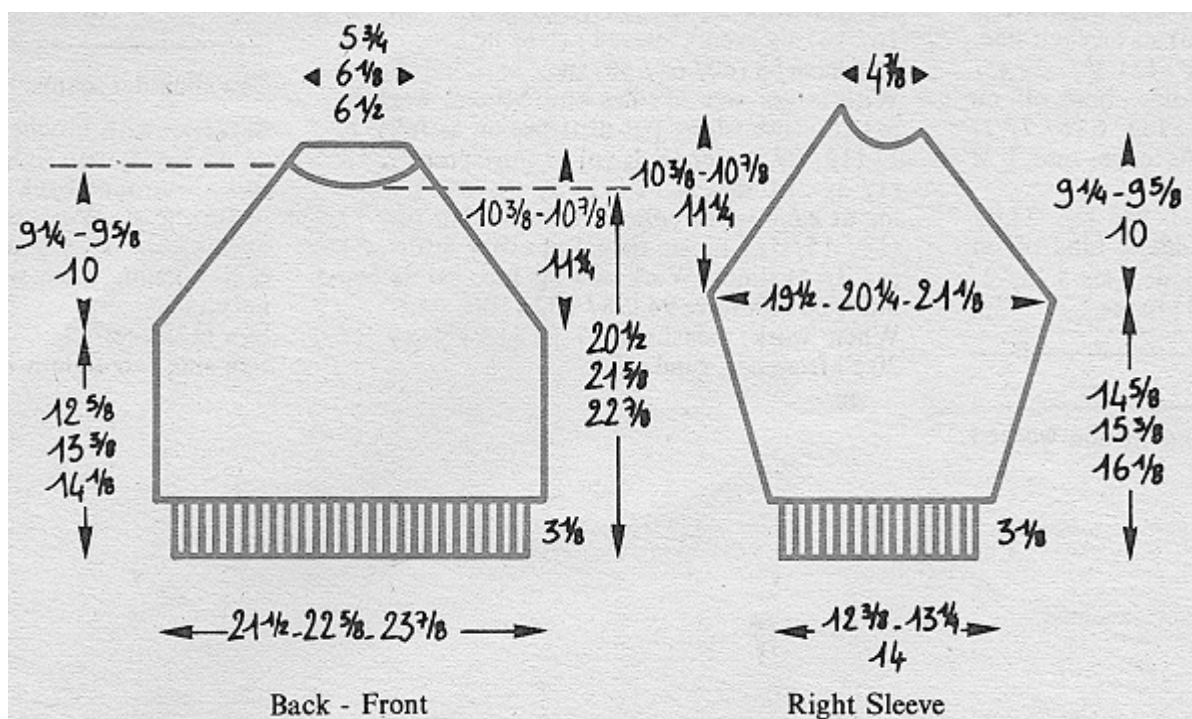
FINISHING

Sew front-sleeve armhole seams and one back-sleeve armhole seam.

Neckband: With smaller size needles, with right side of work facing you, pick up and K about 126 sts around neckline. Work $\frac{3}{4}$ in 1/1 ribbing then bind off.

Sew rem back-sleeve armhole seam and neckband seam. Fold neckband in half toward inside and sl st to pick up row.

Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.



GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

THE CLASSIC STITCHES :

1.1 Ribbing : * Knit 1, purl 1 *.

2.2 Ribbing : * Knit 2, purl 2 *.

Stockinette stitch : * knit 1 row, purl 1 row *.

Reverse Stockinette stitch : * Purl 1 row, knit 1 row *.

Garter Stitch : Knit all rows (1 garter rib = 2 rows).

ASTERISKS :

Little stars that isolate a part of the instructions which are to be repeated.

Example : work * K2, P3 * mean you must work whatever is between the 2 * as many times as is necessary.
