

JACQUARD VEST

Vintage Knitting Pattern



GENERAL NOTES

Before starting your needlework, you must absolutely knit one gauge swatch. In order to do it cast on ten stitches in addition to the indicated number for 4" at the beginning of the instruction and knit about 6". Check if the number of stitches and rows which are obtained with 4" corresponds to the indicated gauge. If the result isn't the same, take a higher number of needle or a lower as far as your knitting work is too loose or too close.

DIFFUSION

All charts are in original French measurements. To convert to inches, multiply centimeter measurements by .394. When working charts refer to translation of French terms. When one more size appears in the instructions than on chart, it is the smallest size.

INSTRUCTIONS

SIZES: Small (6-8), Medium (10-12), Large (14-16)

FINISHED BUST MEASUREMENT: 40 (41¾-44) in.

MATERIALS: Berger du Nord "COTTAGE" 5 (5-6) Naturel; "CREOLE" 1 (2-2) balls Pacific, 1 (2-2) balls Océan, 1 (1-2) balls Corail. Knitting needles sizes 2 and 7 or size to obtain gauge.

GAUGE: 19 sts and 33 rows = 4 in. with large needles in pat st.

RIB — With small needles, k1, p1.

PATTERN STITCH — With large needles, worked over 14 sts and 12 rows. Foll chart for sts; for stripes work 2 rows of each yarn in foll order: * Pacific, Naturel, Ocean, Naturel, Corail, Naturel *, rep from * to *.

POINT MOUSSE (Garter st): K all sts every row.

BACK: With small needles and Naturel cast on 80 (84-90) sts and work in rib for 2¼ in. P 1 row on wrong side of work, inc 16 sts evenly spaced across row — 96 (100-106) sts. Cont in pat st foll chart and stripe pat. Work until piece measures 13 (13-13¾) in. from beg.

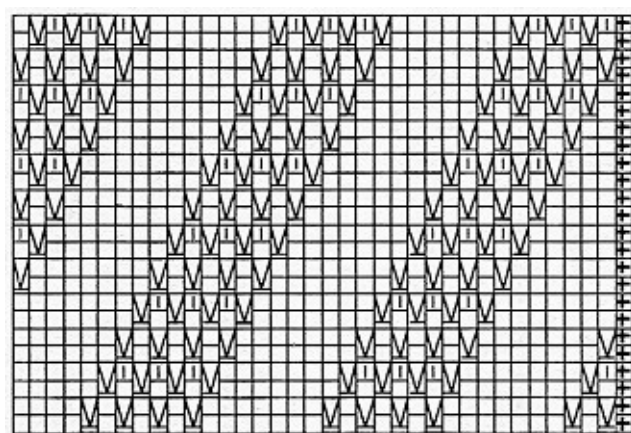
Shape armholes: Bind off 8 sts each side, then bind off every other row 2 sts twice and 1 st twice. Work until 19¼ (20-20¾) in. from beg.

Shape neck: Bind off center 24 (26-28) sts and work each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every other row 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times. At 21¼ (22-22¾) in. from beg, bind off rem 15 (16-18) sts.

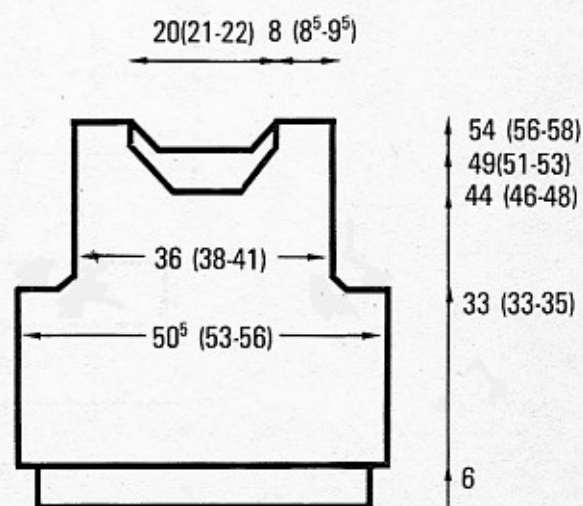
FRONT: Work same as back until piece measures 17¼ (18-18¾) in. from beg.

Shape neck: Bind off center 12 (14-16) sts and work each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every other row 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times. At 21¼ (22-22¾) in. from beg, bind off rem 15 (16-18) sts.

FINISHING: Join front and back at right shoulder. With small needles and Naturel pick up 100 (106-110) sts around neck edge and work in rib for 1 in. Bind off loosely. Sew second shoulder and rib seams. With small needles and Naturel pick up 86 (94-94) sts around each armhole and work in rib for 1 in. Bind off loosely. Sew side seams.
