

Blue Medley Blanket

1990s Crochet Pattern



Finished Size:
36" x 45¹/₂"

MATERIALS

Worsted Weight Yarn:
Variegated - 19 ounces,
(540 grams, 1,075 yards)
Blue - 19 ounces,
(540 grams, 1,075 yards)
Crochet hook, size P (10.00
mm) or size needed for gauge

Note: Each row is worked
across length of Afghan holding
two strands of yarn together.

GAUGE: In pattern,
2 repeats = 2³/₄"; 4 rows = 3"

Gauge Swatch: 4¹/₂"w x 4"h
Holding one strand of
Variegated and one strand of
Blue together, ch 12 **loosely**.
Work same as Afghan for 5
rows.
Finish off.

AFGHAN

Holding one strand of
Variegated and one strand of
Blue together, ch 102 **loosely**.

Row 1 (Right side): Dc in back
ridge of fourth ch from hook
(**Fig. 1, page 2**) and each ch
across (**3 skipped chs count
as first dc**): 100 dc.

Note: Loop a short piece of
yarn around any stitch to mark
Row 1 as **right** side.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; sc in first
dc, ★ ch 2, skip next 2 dc, sc in
next dc; repeat from ★ across:
34 sc and 33 ch-2 sps.

Row 3: Ch 3 (**counts as first
dc, now and throughout**),
turn; (2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in
next sc) across: 100 dc.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn; sc in first
dc, ★ ch 2, skip next 2 dc, sc in
next dc; repeat from ★ across:
34 sc and 33 ch-2 sps.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn; (2 dc in
next ch-2 sp, dc in next sc)
across: 100 dc.

Repeat Rows 4 and 5 until
Afghan measures approximately
36" from beginning ch, ending
by working Row 5.

Finish off.

Holding 4 strands of Variegated
and 4 strands of Blue together,
each 16" long, add fringe in end
of each right side row across
short edges of Afghan (**Figs. 6c
& d**).

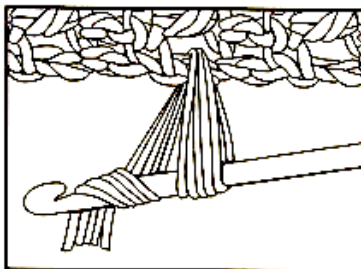
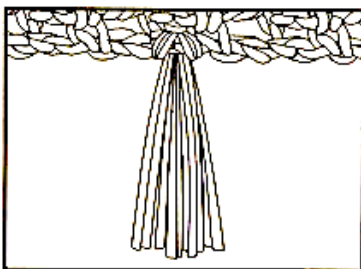

slip stitch (slip st)	= single crochet (sc)
single crochet (sc)	= double crochet (dc)
half double crochet (hdc)	= half treble crochet (htr)
double crochet (dc)	= treble crochet (tr)
treble crochet (tr)	= double treble crochet (dtr)
double treble crochet (dtr)	= triple treble crochet (ttr)
skip	= miss
