FRUIT Potholders ~ Strawberry ~ Orange ~ Pear ~ Lemon ~

1980s Crochet Patterns



STRAWBERRY

SIZE: Approx 7" wide × 6½" long

MATERIALS:

Worsted weight yarn: 21/2 oz bright red;

5 yds medium green;

3 yds white

Size H aluminum crochet hook (or size required for gauge) Size 16 tapestry needle or yarn needle (for embroidery) Plastic ring (1" diameter)

GAUGE: In sc, 11 sts = 3"; 4 rows = 1"

INSTRUCTIONS

(Make 2 sections)

Beg at bottom, with red, ch 7.

ROW 1: Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook; sc in each of next 3 chs, work 2 sc in each of rem 2 chs = 9 sc.

ROW 2: Ch 1, turn; work 2 sc in first sc, sc in each rem sc across = 10 sc (one st increased).

ROW 3: Work even. (Note: To "work even", ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.)

ROW 4: Ch 1, turn; work 3 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc = 13 sc (3 sts increased).

ROW 5: Rep Row 2 = 14 sc.

ROW 6: Ch 1, turn; work 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc = 16 sc (2 sts increased).

ROWS 7 and 8: Rep Row 2, twice. (At end of Row 8, you should have 18 sc.)

ROW 9: Rep Row 4 = 21 sc.

ROWS 10 through 12: Work 3 rows even.

ROW 13: Rep Row 2 = 22 sc.

ROW 14: Rep Row 4 = 25 sc.

ROW 15: Rep Row 2 = 26 sc.

ROWS 16 through 18: Work 3 rows even.

ROW 19 (dec row): Ch 1, turn; dec over first 2 sc as follows: Draw up a lp in each of first 2 sc, YO hook and draw through all 3 lps on hook (dec made); sc in each rem sc across to last 2 sc, dec over last 2 sc = 24 sc (2 sts decreased).

ROW 20: Work even.


ROWS 21 through 24: Rep Rows 19 and 20, twice. (At end of Row 24, you should have 20 sc.) Do not finish off; continue with top shaping as follows:

FIRST HALF: ROW 1: Ch 1, turn; dec over first 2 sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, sl st in next sc (leave rem 10 sts unworked) = 9 sts. ROW 2: Ch 1, turn; sk sl st, dec over next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, dec over last 2 sc = 6 sc. ROW 3: Ch 1, turn; dec over first 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, sl st in last sc = 5 sts. Finish off; weave in ends. Then work second half as follows:

SECOND HALF: Hold section with shaping just worked at top and to your right. **ROW 1:** Join red with a sl st in first unworked st to your right (next to shaping just completed); so in each of next 7 sc, dec over last 2 sc. **ROW 2:** Ch 1, turn; dec over first 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, dec over last 2 sc = 6 sc. **ROW 3:** Ch 1, turn; dec over first 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, sl st in last sc = 5 sts. Finish off; weave in ends.

EMBROIDERY

Embroider seeds on one section for front of potholder as follows: Thread 36" strand of white into tapestry or yarn needle doubled. Work straight sts vertically (Fig 18) between scs of every 2nd or 3rd row, having sts unevenly spaced as shown in photo.



ASSEMBLING

Hold both sections tog, having front section with embroidered seeds facing you. With red, beg at center top and sc sections tog (work sc in each corresponding st/row around).

FINISHING

With green, make a slip knot on hook, then work 16 sc around plastic ring; join with a sl st in beg sc. **Do not finish off; continue with hull as follows:** * Ch 6, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in next ch, sc in each of rem 3 chs (one point completed). Return to ring, sk sc where sl st was worked before point, sk next sc, sl st in next sc; rep from * 3 times more = 4 points. Finish off, leaving approx 10" sewing length. Sew to front of potholder at center top.

ORANGE

SIZE: Approx 7" diameter

MATERIALS:

Worsted weight yarn: 2 oz bright orange;

10 yds medium green

Size H aluminum crochet hook (or size required for gauge)

Plastic ring (1" diameter)

GAUGE: In sc, 4 sts = 1"; 4 rnds = 1"

INSTRUCTIONS

(Make 2 sections)

With orange, ch 2.

RND 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook = 6 sc. Do not join; work continuous rnds (without joining). Use a small safety pin or piece of yarn in contrasting color and make first st of rnd; move marker at beg of each rnd.

RND 2: Inc (increase—work 2 sc in st) in each sc around = 12 sc.

RND 3: * Sc in next sc, inc; rep from * around = 18 sc.

RND 4: * Sc in each of next 2 sc, inc; rep from * around = 24 sc.

RND 5: Sc in next sc, inc; * sc in each of next 3 sc, inc; rep from * to last 2 sc, sc in each of last 2 sc = 30 sc.

RND 6: * Inc, sc in each of next 4 sc; rep from * around = 36 sc.

RND 7: So in each of next 3 sc, inc; * sc in each of next 5 sc, inc; rep from * to last 2 sc, sc in each of last 2 sc = 42 sc.

RND 8: * Sc in each of next 6 sc, inc; rep from * around = 48 sc.

RND 9: So in each of next 4 sc, inc; * sc in each of next 7 sc, inc; rep from * to last 3 sc, sc in each of last 3 sc = 54 sc.

RND 10: Sc in each of next 2 sc, inc; * sc in each of next 8 sc, inc; rep from * to last 6 sc, sc in each of last 6 sc = 60 sc.

RND 11: * Inc, sc in each of next 9 sc; rep from * around = 66 sc.


RND 12: So in each of next 6 sc, inc; * sc in each of next 10 sc, inc; rep from * to last 4 sc, sc in each of last 4 sc = 72 sc.

RND 13: So in each of next 3 sc, inc; * sc in each of next 11 sc, inc; rep from * to last 8 sc, sc in each of last 8 sc = 78 sc.

RND 14: So in each so around, join with a sl st in beg so. Finish off, leaving approx 36" sewing length (on one section only).

ASSEMBLING

Hold both sections tog, having wrong side of sts on outside of potholder. Sew sections tog with overcast st in outer lps only (Fig 19) of corresponding sts around.



FINISHING

With medium green, make a slip knot on hook, then work 16 sc around plastic ring; join with a sl st in beg sc. Finish off, leaving approx 8" sewing length. Sew ring to edge of potholder.

LEAF (make 2): With medium green, ch 9. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next ch; hdc in next ch, dc in each of next 2 chs; hdc in next ch, sc in next ch, 3 sc in last ch. Continuing on opposite side of starting chain, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in each of next 2 sts; hdc in next st, sc in each of last 2 sts; join with a sl st in beg sc. Finish off, leaving approx 8" sewing length. Sew leaves to top of potholder as positioned in photo.

PEAR

SIZE: Approx 6 1/2 " wide × 8" long

MATERIALS:

Worsted weight yarn: 21/2 oz light green;

10 yds medium green

Size H aluminum crochet hook (or size required for gauge)

Plastic ring (1" diameter)

GAUGE: In sc, 4 sts = 1"; 4 rnds = 1"

INSTRUCTIONS

(Make 2 sections)

With light green, ch 5.

RND 1: Work 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook; sc in each of next 2 chs, work 3 sc in last ch. Continuing on opposite side of starting chain, sc in each of next 2 sts = 10 sc. Do not join; work continuous rnds (without joining). Use a small safety pin or piece of yarn in contrasting color and mark first st of rnd; move marker at beg of each rnd.

RND 2: Work 2 sc in next sc, 3 sc in next sc; 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc; 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of rem 3 sc = 16 sc.

Note: On following rnds, "inc" means to increase (work 2 sc in st).

RND 3: Work (inc, sc in next sc) 4 times; sc in each of next 3 sc, work 3 sc in next sc (2 sts increased), sc in each of rem 4 sc = 22 sc.

RND 4: Inc, sc in each of next 2 sc; work (inc, sc in next sc) twice; inc, sc in each of next 2 sc; inc, sc in each of next 4 sc; inc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of rem 4 sc = 30 sc.

RND 5: Sc in each of next 4 sc, inc; work (sc in each of next 3 sc, inc) 3 times; sc in each of next 4 sc, inc; sc in next sc, work 3 sc in next sc (2 sts increased); sc in next sc, inc; sc in each of rem 4 sc = 38 sc.

RND 6: Sc in each of next 2 sc, inc; work (sc in each of next 3 sc, inc) 4 times; sc in each of next 9 sc, inc in each of next 3 sc; sc in each of rem 7 sc = 46 sc.

RND 7: Sc in next sc, inc; work (sc in each of next 3 sc, inc) 6 times; sc in each of next 6 sc, inc; sc in each of next 2 sc, inc; sc in next sc, inc; sc in each of next 2 sc, inc; sc in each of rem 5 sc = 57 sc.

RND 8: Sc in each sc around.

RND 9: Work (sc in each of next 4 sc, inc) 6 times; sc in each of next 13 sc, work (inc, sc in next sc) 3 times; sc in each of rem 8 sc = 66 sc.

RND 10: Sc in each sc around.

RND 11: Sc in each of next 2 sc, inc; work (sc in each of next 5'sc, inc) 6 times; sc in each of next 13 sc, work 3 hdc in next sc (2 sts increased); work 2 hdc in each of next 2 sc (2 sts increased), work 3 hdc in next sc (2 sts increased), sc in each of rem 10 sc = 79 sts.

RND 12: Sc in each st around.

RND 13: Work (sc in each of next 4 sc, inc) 9 times; sc in each of next 16 sc, work 3 hdc in next sc (2 sts increased); work (2 hdc in next sc, hdc in next sc) twice, work 2 hdc in next sc; work 3 hdc in next sc (2 sts increased), sc in each of rem 11 sc = 95 sts.

RND 14: Sc in each of next 73 sts, hdc in each of next 8 sts, sc in each of rem 14 sts; join with a sl st in beg sc. Finish off, leaving approx 36" sewing length (on one section only).

ASSEMBLING AND FINISHING

Work same as for Orange Potholder (see page 14).

LEMON

SIZE: Approx 6" wide x 8" long

MATERIALS:

Worsted weight yarn: 2 oz lemon yellow;

10 yds medium green

Size H aluminum crochet hook (or size required for gauge)

Plastic ring (1" diameter)

GAUGE: In sc, $4 \text{ sts} = 1^{"}$; $4 \text{ rnds} = 1^{"}$

INSTRUCTIONS

(Make 2 sections)

With yellow, ch 5.

RND 1: Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook; sc in each of next 2 chs, 3 sc in last ch. Continuing on opposite side of starting chain, sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next st = 10 sc. Do not join; work continuous rnds (without joining). Use a small safety pin or piece of yarn in contrasting color and mark first st of rnd; move marker at beg of each rnd.

RND 2: * Work 3 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * once more = 18 sc.

Note: On following rnds, "inc" means to increase (work 2 sc in st).

RND 3: Work (sc in next sc, inc) twice; sc in each of next 4 sc, work (inc, sc in next sc) 3 times; sc in each of next 3 sc, inc = 24 sc.

RND 4: (Scin next sc, inc) twice; sc in each of next 2 sc,

inc; so in each of next 3 sc, inc; sc in each of next 2 sc, inc; sc in next sc, inc; sc in each of next 2 sc, inc; sc in each of next 3 sc, inc, sc in last sc = 32 sc.

RND 5: Inc, work (sc in each of next 2 sc, inc) 3 times; sc in each of next 3 sc, inc; work (sc in each of next 2 sc, inc) 4 times; sc in each of next 3 sc, inc, sc in each of last 2 sc = 42 sc.

RND 6: Sc in each sc around.

RND 7: * Work (sc in each of next 2 sc, inc) 3 times, sc in each of next 12 sc; rep from * once more = 48 sc.

RND 8: Sc in next sc, work (inc, sc in each of next 2 sc) 5 times; sc in each of next 9 sc, work (inc, sc in each of next 2 sc) 5 times, sc in each of last 8 sc = 58 sc.

RND 9: * Work (sc in each of next 4 sc, inc) 3 times, sc in each of next 14 sc; rep from * once more = 64 sc.

RND 10: * Work (sc in each of next 3 sc, inc) 5 times, sc in each of next 12 sc; rep from * once more = 74 sc.

RND 11: Sc in each sc around.

RND 12: * Inc, work (sc in each of next 4 sc, inc) twice; sc in each of next 2 sc, work 3 sc in next sc (2 sts increased); sc in each of next 2 sc, inc; work (sc in each of next 4 sc, inc) twice, sc in each of next 10 sc; rep from * once more = 90 sc. RND 13: Sc in each of next 17 sc, work 3 sc in next sc; sc in each of next 44 sc, work 3 sc in next sc; sc in each of rem 27 sc, join with a sl st in beg sc = 94 sc. Finish off, leaving approx 36" sewing length (on one section only).

ASSEMBLING AND FINISHING

Work same as for Orange Potholder (see page 14).
