Multicolor Summer Tank Top

1970s Crochet Pattern – Easy Intermediate Level



INSTRUCTIONS

MATERIALS: 100 grs. MADEMOISELLE PINGOUIN FANTAISIE (light weight yarn) in Yellow and Green mixture (A) and 50 grs. MADEMOISELLE PINGOUIN (light weight yarn) in Yellow (B). Crochet hooks no. C/2 and B/1. (For corresponding amounts of your favorite yarns, see the interchangeable chart on page 6). SIZES: To fit bust measurement of 34 inches. Directions for sizes 32, 36 and 38 inches are given in brackets.


GAUGE: 11 patterns and 14 rows to 4 inches. (one pattern = 1 ch. and 1 hdc.).

Front: With A col. and size C2 hook make a ch. of 84 (80: 88: 92) sts. and work in pattern thus:- 1st row: 3 ch., 1 hdc., in 2nd ch., 1 ch., skip 1 st., 1 hdc. rep. to to end of row. 2nd row and every foll. row: As 1st row, working the hdc. in the hdc. of previous row; thus forming 43 (41: 45: 47) patterns of 1 ch. and 1 hdc. Work straight until measurement is 12 \(\frac{3}{4}\) (12 \(\frac{1}{4}\): 13: 13 \(\frac{1}{2}\)) ins. from beg. SHAPE ARMHOLES. Leave 4 patts. unworked at beg. and end of next row and 1 patt. at beg. and end of next 3 alt. rows. At 13 (12 \(\frac{3}{4}\): 13 \(\frac{1}{2}\): 14) ins. from beg.

SHAPE NECK. Leave center 15 (13: 17: 19) patts. unworked and finish each side separately, and at neck edges leave 1 patt. on next 3 alt. rows. When armhole measures 8 ($7 \pm 8 \pm 8 \pm$) ins. fasten off.

Back: With A col. and size C2 hook make a ch. of 78 (74: 82: 86) sts. and work in patt. (40 (38: 42: 44) patterns) and work straight until measurement is 12 \(\frac{1}{4}\) (12 \(\frac{1}{4}\): 13: 13 \(\frac{1}{4}\)) ins. from beg. SHAPE ARMHOLES. Leave 4 patts. unworked at beg. and end of next row and 1 patt. at beg. and end of next 3 alt. rows, but when measurement is 17\(\frac{1}{4}\) (16 \(\frac{1}{2}\): 18: 18 \(\frac{3}{4}\)) ins. from beg. SHAPE NECK. Leave center 12 (10: 14: 16) patts. unworked and finish each side separately and at neck edges leave 1 patt. on next 3 alt. rows. When armhole measures 8 (7 \(\frac{1}{2}\): 8 \(\frac{3}{4}\)) ins. fasten off.

To make up: Sew side and shoulder seams. Pick up 120 (112: 128: 136) sts. along foundation ch. of back and front and work with B col. and size B1 hook in sc. for 6 rounds, then 1 round corded edge st. (s.c. worked from left to right) Pick up 152 (144: 160: 168) sts. round neck edge and with B col. and size B1 hook work 2 rounds dc. Next round: Work in sc. but along front, from one shoulder seam to the other dec. thus: * 6 sc., 1 dec.' (put hook in 1 st., pull loop thou, put hook in next st., pull loop thou, yo., pull loop throu the 3 loops on hook) * Work another round sc. 5th round: As 3rd round. Work another round sc., then 1 round in corded edge st. and fasten off. Pick up 85 (81: 89: 93) sts. round each armhole edge and work in sc. for 6 rounds, but on the 3rd round dec. twice at underarm. Work 1 round corded edge st. and fasten off.
