

Navy Mesh Pullover

1990s Crochet Pattern



SIZE: Misses' small (medium-large).
Garment measurement around under-
arms about 34(38-42)".

MATERIALS: No. 10 crochet
cotton— about 6(8-10) ozs. Steel cro-
chet hook No. 5, OR SIZE NEEDED
TO OBTAIN GAUGE. Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 7 ch-1 mesh = 2".

BACK: Loosely ch 124 (136-152).

Row 1: Starting in fifth ch from hook,
dc in each dc across—121(133-149)
dc, counting turning ch as dc. Ch 4
(counts as first dc and ch 1 of next
row), turn. **Row 2:** Skip first 2 dc, *
dc in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc; repeat
from * across, end dc in top ch of
turning ch—60(66-74) ch-1 mesh. Ch
4, turn. Repeat Row 2 for pat. Contin-
ue in pat until piece measures
12½(13-13½)" from beg, or desired
length to underarm. Ch 26 to turn at
end of last row, temporarily drop
loop from hook.

Shape Sleeves: With a separate ball
of yarn, join thread to top of last st at
opposite end of row, ch 22. Fasten
off. Pick up dropped loop, dc in 7th
ch from hook, ch 1, skip next ch, * dc
in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch; repeat

from * across foundation ch for
sleeve, work across body in ch-1
mesh as established, continue to
work ch-1 mesh across ch at opposite
edge—82(88-96) ch-1 mesh. Work
even in ch-1 mesh until piece mea-
sures 3½(4-4½)" above beg of sleeve
shaping.

Neck Shaping: Mark center 14 mesh
for center of neck shaping. Work
across in ch-1 mesh to within one
mesh of center marked mesh, do not
work a ch-1 for last mesh before
marked mesh, dc in dc of first
marked mesh—1 mesh dec worked.
Ch 3, turn. Work across next row as
usual. Now, dec 1 mesh at neck edge
only, in manner established, on every
other row 4 times more. Work even
on remaining mesh until piece mea-
sures 6½(7-7½)" above beg of sleeve
shaping.

FRONT: Work as for Back.

FINISHING: Sew shoulder seams
and side/underarm seams. Work 1
rnd sc loosely around neckline. If you
wish to draw in bottom edge, work 1
or 2 rnds sc with smaller hook.
