



SILVIA BEANIE HAT - Fancy Rib Stitch

A textured beanie knitted from the bottom up in the round. Required knitting skills: intermediate.

ONE ADULT SIZE

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS (inches/centimeters)

Circumference (unstretched): 17" /51 cm - will fit heads measuring 19-23" /48-58 cm around

Height: approx 9½" /24 cm

RECOMMENDED YARN

¾ skein Cascade Yarns Pacific or other worsted medium-weight (4) wool/acrylic yarn (213yds /195m, 3.5oz /100g per skein)

RECOMMENDED NEEDLES

US #8 (5 mm) long (20-24"/50-60 cm) and/or short (16"/40 cm) circular and double-pointed needles for body

US #7 (4.5 mm) short (16"/40 cm) circular needle for rib

NOTIONS

Ring marker, yarn needle

GAUGE

22 sts and 25 rnds in pattern (unstretched) on #8 needle = 4"/10 cm

ABBREVIATIONS

k: knit	rs: right side
p: purl	ws: wrong side
st(s): stitch(es)	rem: remaining
m: marker	lc: left cable over 2 sts:
dp: double-pointed	with 2 sts on left end of needle, k 2 nd st behind 1 st st and k 1 st st
CO: cast on	rc: right cable over 2 sts:
rnd(s): round(s)	with 2 sts on left end of needle, k 2 nd st in front, then k 1 st st; <i>alternative:</i> insert right end of needle to both sts as if to k2tog and slip, then slip both back to left end of needle (with 1 st st behind 2 nd st) and k each
k2tog: knit 2 sts together	
p2tog: purl 2 sts together	
ktbl: through back loop	
rep: repeat	
approx: approximately

TUTORIAL

Swatch. Using circular needle, CO sts with multiple of 7 and work as instructed below for body of this hat. Work on rs, imitating partial rounds and leaving sufficient strands in back when starting next row at right end of circular needle.

Rib

With smaller needle, CO **98** sts, place m and join to work in the round.

Rnds 1-4: *k1 tbl, p2, k2 tbl, p2, rep from * around.

Change to larger needle and proceed with body.

Body

Rnds 1-2: *k1 tbl, p2, k2 (through front loop unlike tbl previously), p2, rep from * around.

Rnd 3: *k1 tbl, p2, rc, p2, rep from * around.

Rnd 4: *k1 tbl, p2, k2, p2, rep from * around.

Rnd 5: *k1 tbl, p1, rc, lc, p1, rep from * around.

Rnd 6: *k1 tbl, p1, k4, p1, rep from * around.

Rnds 7 and 8: *k1 tbl, p2, k2, p2, rep from * around.

Next rnds to end of body: rep (rnds **3-8**) **5** times.

Crown

Change to shorter circular and dp needles as needed.

Rnd 1: *k1 tbl, p2tog, rc, p2tog, rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 2: *k1 tbl, p1, k2, p1, rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 3: *k1 tbl, rc, lc, rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 4: *k1 tbl, k4, rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 5: *k1 tbl, p1, k2, p1, rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 6: *k1 tbl, p1, k2tog, p1, rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnds 7, 8 and 9: *k1 tbl, p1, k1, p1, rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 10 (*consider last st of previous rnd as first st of this rnd*): k2tog around.

Rnd 11: k2tog around.

Finishing

Break yarn leaving approx 6"/15 cm end.

Thread end through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off.
