

# Star Quilt

1990s Crochet Pattern



**SIZE:** About 63" square.

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark Red Heart® Super Saver (8 oz. skeins)—5 skeins color No. 316 Soft White; 4 skeins color No. 384 Skipper Blue. Crochet hooks sizes G and H, OR

**SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE.**

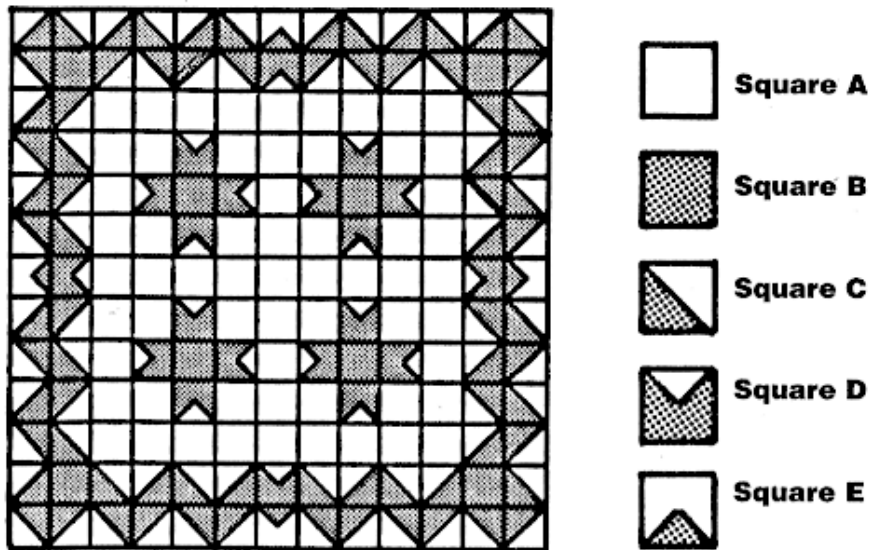
**GAUGE:** Granny Square = 4¼" square with H hook.

**GRANNY SQUARE A:** Solid White Square. Make 61. With H hook and White, ch 6 and join with sl st to form a ring. **Rnd 1:** Ch 3 for first dc, 2 dc in ring, ch 2 for corner, (3 dc in ring, ch 2 for corner) 3 times, join with sl st to top of starting ch-3—4 corners established. **Rnd 2:** Sl st to ch-2 corner, ch 3 for first dc, in same corner

work 2 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc, ch 1, (in next ch-2 space work 3 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc, ch 1) 3 times, join with sl st to top of starting ch-3. **Rnd 3:** Sl st to ch-2 corner, ch 3 for first dc, in same corner work 2 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc, \* ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1, ch 1, in next corner work 3 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc; repeat from \* twice more, end ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1, ch 1, join with sl st to top of starting ch-3. Fasten off.

**GRANNY SQUARE B:** Solid Blue Square. Make 8. Using Blue, make same as Granny Square A.

**GRANNY SQUARE C:** Square is half Blue and half White, with color changes on diagonal corners. Make



76. With H hook and Blue, ch 6, join with sl st to form a ring. **Rnd 1 (right side):** Ch 3 for first dc, work 2 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc in ring, ch 1, drop Blue to wrong side of work, pick up White and ch 1, in ring work (3 dc, ch 2) twice, join with sl st to top of starting ch-3—4 corners established with colors changed on opposite diagonal corners. Turn. **Rnd 2 (wrong side):** With White, sl st in corner, ch 3 for first dc, 2 dc in same corner, ch 1, in next corner work 3 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc, ch 1, in next corner work 3 dc, ch 1, drop White to wrong side, pick up Blue and ch 1, 3 dc in same corner, ch 1, in next corner work 3 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc in next corner, ch 2, join with sl st to top of starting ch-3. Turn. **Rnd 3 (right side):** With Blue, sl st in corner, ch 3 for first dc, 2 dc in same corner, \* ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1, ch 1, in corner work 3 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1, ch 1, 3 dc in corner \*, ch 1, cut Blue, pick up White with ch 1, 3 dc in same corner; repeat from \* to \*, ch 2, join. Fasten off.

**GRANNY SQUARE D:** Square is three-quarters Blue, one-quarter

White. Make 20. With H hook and Blue, ch 6 and join with sl st to form a ring. **Rnd 1:** Ch 3 for first dc, work 2 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc in ring, ch 2, 3 dc in ring, ch 1, drop Blue to wrong side, pick up White with ch 1, 3 dc in ring, ch 2, join to top of starting ch-3. Turn. **Rnd 2 (wrong side):** With White, sl st in corner, ch 3 for first dc, 2 dc in same corner, ch 1, 3 dc in next corner, ch 1, drop White to wrong side, pick up Blue with ch 1, 3 dc in same corner, (ch 1, work corner in next corner) twice, ch 1, 3 dc in next corner, ch 2, join. Turn. **Rnd 3 (right side):** With Blue, sl st in corner, ch 3 for first dc, 2 dc in same corner, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1, ch 1, work corner in corner) twice, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1, ch 1, 3 dc in corner, ch 1, drop Blue to wrong side, pick up White with ch 1, 3 dc in same corner, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1, ch 1, 3 dc in corner, ch 2, join. Fasten off.

**GRANNY SQUARE E:** Square is three-quarters White, one-quarter Blue. Make 4. **Rnds 1 through 3:** Make same as Granny Square D working White in place of Blue and Blue in place of White.

**FINISHING:** Following Diagram, join squares into strips as follows: Holding 2 pieces with right sides together, working through two thicknesses, join yarn with sc in corner, (ch 3, sc in next ch-1) twice, ch 3, sc in corner. Cut yarn. When joining squares with 2 Blue edges, use Blue yarn; for all other joinings, use White.

**Joining Strips:** When joining strips, change colors as required. \* Work across square as before, ending with sc in corner, ch 1, skip joining, sc in next corner; repeat from \* across until 2 strips are joined.

**Border—Rnd 1:** With H hook, join White in corner of afghan and ch 3 for first dc, in same corner work 2 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc, \* (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 ) to joining, ch 1, dc in corner before joining, dc in joining, dc in corner after joining; repeat from \* as established to corner, in corner work 3 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc; repeat from \* around as established, join. **Rnd 2:** Sl st to corner, ch 3 for first dc, in same corner work 2 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc, \*

(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1) to corner, in corner work 3 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc; repeat from \* around as established, join. Cut yarn. **Rnd 3:** Join Blue in any corner, ch 3 for first dc, in same corner work 2 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc, \* \*\* ch 1, dc in next ch-1, (yo and insert hook from front to back to front around dc two rows below, complete as dc—long dc completed), dc in same ch-1; repeat from \*\* as established to corner, in corner work 3 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc; repeat from \* around as established, join. **Rnd 4:** With Blue, repeat Rnd 2. Cut yarn. **Rnds 5 and 6:** Change to G hook. With White, repeat Rnds 3 and 4. Cut yarn. **Rnds 7 and 8:** With Blue, repeat Rnds 3 and 4. **Rnd 9:** With Blue, sl st to corner, ch 3 for first dc, in same corner work 2 dc, ch 3, sl st in last dc for picot, 3 dc in same corner, \* (picot, 3 dc in next ch-1) to corner, in corner work 3 dc, picot, and 3 dc; repeat from \* around as established, join. Fasten off.
