MATERIALS:

4-ply yarn in:

4 ozs brown

2 ozs white

Small amounts of 4-ply yarn in:

Red

Tan

Black

Crochet hook size F/5 (4.00mm)

Fiberfill

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 5 sc = 1"; 5 sc rnds = 1"

SIZE: 15" tall

NOTE: Do not join rnds, mark 1st st of each rnd.

ARMS (make 2)

Rnd 1: With brown yarn, ch 2, work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around. (12)

Rnd 3: (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) rep around. (18)

Rnd 4: Sc around, inc 2 sts evenly sp around. (20)

Rnds 5-26: Sc in each st around. Fasten off at the end of Rnd 26. Stuff arms and set aside.

LEGS (make 2)

Rnd 1: With brown yarn, ch 5, work 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 sc in each

next 2 chs, 3 sc in last ch, working on opposite side of foundation ch, 2 sc in each of next 2 chs. (14)

Rnd 2: * (2 sc in next st) 3 times, sc in next 4 sts, rep from * around. (20)

Rnd 3: *(2 sc in next st, sc in next st) 3 times, sc in next 4 sts, rep from * around. (26)

Rnd 4: * (2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) 3 times, sc in next 4 sts, rep from * around. (32)

Rnd 5: Working in back lps only, sc in each st around.

Rnd 6: (Sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 3 sts) 3 times, sc in each rem st around. (29)

Rnd 7: (Sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 2 sts) 3 times, sc in each rem st around. (26)

Rnd 8: (Sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next st) 3 times, sc in each rem st around. (23)

Rnd 9: (Sc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, sc in each rem st around. (20)

Rnds 10-13: Sc in each st around.

Rnds 14-17: 2 sc in next st, sc in each rem st. (24 sts at the end of Rnd 17).

Rnds 18 & 19: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 20: 2 sc in next st, sc in each rem st around. (25)

Rnd 21: 2 sc in each next 2 sts, sc in each rem st around, fasten off.

Rnds 1-13: Rep Rnds 1-13 of 1st leg

for second leg.

Rnd 14: Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each rem st. (21)

Rnds 15-17: Sc around, inc'ing above the inc of previous rnd. (24 sts at the end of Rnd 17).

Rnds 18 & 19: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 20: Sc in next 9 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each rem st. (25)

Rnd 21: Sc in next 9 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each rem st, do not fasten off. (27)

BODY

Rnd 1: Sc in next 12 sts, sc in 4th st of last rnd of 1st leg, sc in each rem st of both legs. (54) Feet should be facing in the same direction!

Rnds 2-4: Sc around, inc 4 sts evenly sp around. (66 sts at the end of Rnd 4).

Rnds 5-7: Sc around, working a 1 st inc at the back. (69 sts at end of Rnd 7).

Rnds 8-12: Sc around, working a 1 st dec at back. (64 sts at end of Rnd 12).

Rnds 13-15: Sc in each st around. Stuff legs.

Rnd 16: Sc around, dec 4 sts evenly sp around. (60)

Rnd 17: Sc in each st around.

Rnds 18-21: Rep Rnds 16 and 17 two times. (52 sts at end of Rnd 21).

Rnd 22: * Sc to 5 sts away from center of side of body, flatten an arm, work sc through both thicknesses of arm and next 10 sts of body, rep from * once, sc in each rem st around.

Rnd 23: Sc around, dec 2 sts evenly sp around. (50) Stuff body.

Rnd 24: Sc around, dec 5 sts evenly sp around. (45)

Rnd 25: * Dec 1 sc over next 2 sts, rep from * until 28 sts rem.

Rnd 26: Sl st in each st around, do not fasten off. Finish stuffing body.

HEAD

Rnd 1: Work 2 sc in each st around of Rnd 25 of body. (56)

Rnds 2-10: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 11: Sc around, dec 4 sts evenly sp around. (52)

Rnd 12: Sc in each st around.

Rnds 13-22: Rep Rnds 11 and 12 five times. Fasten off leaving a 12" length of yarn at the end of Rnd 22. Stuff head and sew closed.

EARS (make 2)

Row 1: Attach tan yarn with a sc about 1¼" from top of head at side, work another sc in same sp, work 2 sc in next 5 sps working down side of head, ch 1, turn. (12)

Row 2: Sc in each st across, ch 1, turn.

Rows 3-5: Dec 1 sc over next 2 sts, sc across to within last 2 sts, dec 1 sc over next 2 sts, ch 1, turn. (6 sts at the end of Row 5). Fasten off at the end of Row 5.

Work back of ear with brown yarn in the same manner and in the same sps behind the front of ear.

Holding both sections of ear tog, attach brown with a sc at at base of

ear and sc around the outer edge to the other side of ear, fasten off. Tack down sides of ear so ear cups forward.

SNOUT

Rnd 1: With tan yarn, ch 2, work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sl st to join, ch 1, turn. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around, join, ch 1, turn. (12)

Rnd 3: (Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) rep around, join, ch 1, turn. (18)

Rnd 4: (Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) rep around, join, ch 1, turn. (24)

Rnd 5: (Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) rep around, join, ch 1, turn. (30)

Rnd 6: Sc in each st around, join, turn.

Rnd 7: Sc in next 20 sts, sl st in next st, fasten off leaving a 12" length of yarn. Stuff and sew on snout with 10 rem sts of Rnd 7 at bottom and these 10 sts are attached to Rnd 4 of head.

FACE

Nose

With black yarn and yarn needle, embroider nose over Rnds 2 and 3 of snout, using long sts.

Mouth

With black yarn and yarn needle, embroider mouth as shown in satin stitch.

Eyes

With white yarn and yarn needle, embroider eyes in long stitches just above the snout evenly spaced with 1" between eyes.

Tongue

With red yarn, ch 2, work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook, fasten off. Sew to side of mouth.

HAT

With white yarn, ch 45, sl st to join to form a ring, ch 1.

Rnd 1: Sc in each ch around, join, ch 1, turn. (45)

Rnd 2-8: Sc in each st around, join, ch 1, turn. Do not turn at the end of Rnd 8.

Rnd 9: Working around the post of each st, sc around, join, ch 3, turn.

Rnd 10: Dc in same st as joining, work 2 dc in each rem st around, join, ch 3, turn. (90)

Rnds 11-17: Dc in each st around, join, ch 3, do not turn. Ch 1 at the end of Rnd 17.

Rnd 18: (Dec 1 sc over next 2 sts) rep around, join, fasten off leaving a 12" length of yarn. Weave length through Rnd 18, pull tight and fasten off.

HAT EMBROIDERY

With red yarn and yarn needle, working over Rnds 3-6 of hat, embroider in chain stitch the name TED.

HAT FINISHING

Hat goes over one ear on side of head. With yarn needle and a length of white yarn, weave yarn in and out sts of Rnd 1 of hat, catching sts on head to hold in place. Tie in a bow at back of hat. This way the hat can be removed if desired.

APRON

Row 1: With white yarn, ch 4, 6 dc in 4th ch from hook, ch 3, turn. (7)

Row 2: Sk 1st st, 2 dc in each st across, ch 3, turn. (13)

Row 3: Sk 1st st, (dc in next st, 2 dc in next st) rep across, ch 3, turn. (19)

Rows 4-11: Sk 1st st, dc in each st across, inc'ing 6 sts evenly sp across, ch 3, turn. (67 sts at the end of Row 11). Fasten off at the end of Row 11.

Work 4 rows of 13 dc sts across top center of apron over Rows 1-3 of bottom of apron. Fasten off at the end of the 4th row.

APRON TRIM

With red yarn, with right side of bib facing you, attach yarn in left top corner of bib, ch 30 (neck tie), sc in opposite end of bib, sc across top of bib, sc down side of bib, sc across edge of apron, at end of Row 11, ch 30 (apron string tie), sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sl st in each rem ch, sc across bottom of apron, inc sts as needed for fullness, at end of Row 11, ch 30, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sl st in each rem ch across, sc up side edge of apron, sc up side edge of bib, join, fasten off.

APRON EMBROIDERY

With red yarn and yarn needle, working in chain stitch, embroider the word HUG over the 1st and 2nd rows of bib centered; the word THE over Rows 2 and 3 of apron centered; the word COOK, evenly spaced below the HONEY! evenly spaced below.

Place the apron on the bear and tie the apron strings in the back, but don't let Teddy in the kitchen, he gets everything sticky!
